Long Burn Times

Progressive Burn Technology is designed to keep hot embers in the firebox after a nights burning. This process is achieved by restricting the air in the back of the firebox, leaving hot embers for you to start up your insert again.

Clean Burning

Secondary air tubes add super-heated air to the fire as the burn progresses to the front for high efficiency and low emissions.

- ultra strong air wash helps to keep the glass clean
- radiant heat is maximized through the large glass area (177 sq. in.)
- up to 18" log length loaded north/south on a 1200 firebox


1200 & 1700 Air Flow Path





2100 Air Flow Path
